Vision Statement

At all times, professional users of Mission Critical and Business Critical communications should have information available to them, either in vehicle or on foot, that enables them to perform their tasks in the most efficient and effective manner possible.

It is the vision of the CCBG that Mission Critical and Business Critical users should be able to access their information systems, intranet and internet information at Broadband speeds using their professional mobile devices wherever they are and whenever they have the need.

Mission Critical and Business Critical users should therefore have access to a robust and reliable Mobile Broadband capability that uses common technologies, interoperable solutions and harmonised spectrum (which should, as far as possible, be worldwide).

This capability should meet the specific needs of the Critical Communications user in the essential functionality and resilience that they are already experiencing for their mission critical voice with technologies such as TETRA, Tetrapol, P25, GSM-R and others.

Mission Statement

The CCBG will drive the development of one or more common standards for Mobile Broadband that fulfil the mobile applications needs of users who operate in a Critical Communications environment and will lobby for appropriate harmonised spectrum in which to deploy such services.

The CCBG will develop a Roadmap that includes an evolutionary principle in which several paths are described.

The CCBG will educate, debate and discuss this subject with others who have an interest in Mission Critical Mobile Broadband (MCMBB).
